



GENERAL NOTES:

- A. EXISTING WALLS, DOORS, FURNITURE, ETC. SHOWN DASHED TO BE REMOVED.
- B. GENERAL CONTRACTOR TO VERIFY ALL AREAS THAT ARE NOT IN SCOPE OF WORK TO BE SEALED OFF FROM CONSTRUCTION AREA TO MINIMIZE MIGRATION OF CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS AND DUST.
- C. ALL EXISTING CONDITIONS ARE TO BE FIELD VERIFIED BY CONTRACTOR.
- D. FLOORING, WALL FINISHES, AND CEILING SURROUNDING RENOVATION AREAS SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM DAMAGE DUE TO CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC OR ACTUAL WORK.
- E. INTENT OF THE DEMOLITION PLAN IS TO REMOVE ALL THE EXISTING CONSTRUCTION ITEMS NOT REQUIRED FOR THE FINISHED BUILDING. ALL ITEMS NOT REQUIRED FOR THE FINISHED BUILDING SHALL BE REMOVED, EVEN IF NOT INDIVIDUALLY ENUMERATED.
- F. TILE IN PORTION EXISTING KITCHEN TO REMAIN. PORTION TO BE REMOVED.
- G. AT ALL LOCATIONS WHERE FLOORING IS SCHEDULED TO BE REMOVED, CONTRACTOR IS TO MECHANICALLY CLEAN THE FLOOR AS REQUIRED TO PROPERLY INSTALL NEW FLOORING. SOLVENTS MAY NOT COMPLETELY CLEAN THE EXISTING CONCRETE TO PROVIDE AN ACCEPTABLE BASE FOR THE NEW FLOOR FINISH'S ADHESIVE. THEREFORE MECHANICAL MEANS MAY BE REQUIRED TO CLEAN THE FLOORS COMPLETELY.
- J. EXISTING FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEM AND ALARM TO BE PROTECTED.

NOTES BY NUMBER:

- 1 EXISTING DOOR AND FRAME TO BE REMOVED. REMOVE ALL RELATED COMPONENTS ASSOCIATED TO ATTACHMENT OF FRAME TO WALL. INFILL TO MATCH EXISTING.
- 2 EXISTING WALLS TO BE REMOVED
- 3 GENERAL CONTRACTOR TO EVALUATE FEASIBILITY OF REUSING EXISTING ELECTRICAL PANELS FOR NEW SPACE, CONSULT WITH OWNER.
- 4 PORTION OF EXISTING STOREFRONT TO BE REMOVED FOR INSTALLATION OF NEW ENTRY DOORS. SEE FLOOR PLAN AND DOOR SCHEDULE FOR MOORE INFORMATION.
- 5 REMOVE LOWERED CEILING
- 6 REMOVE ALL EXISTING LIGHTING, CEILING REGISTERS, MECHANICAL DUCTING AND CEILING COMPONENTS, TYPICAL
- 7 EXISTING REAR DOOR TO REMAIN.
- 8 REMOVE EXISTING MILLWORK.
- 9 REMOVE ALL PLUMBING FIXTURES, TYPICAL.
- 10 EXISTING COLUMN TO REMAIN, TYPICAL.
